1 General

1.1 Membership fees for 2007 are as follows:

New Membership \$350 – New membership includes 8 hours of mandatory volunteer help. No track credit.

Renewal Membership \$350 - With option of 8 hours of volunteer help to receive \$100. track credit

Early Renewal (must be received or postmarked by January 31st). With option of 8 hours of volunteer help to receive \$100 track credit.

Mid season (July 1st – October 31st) - \$225. Includes 8 hours of mandatory volunteer help. No track credit.

November thru December - \$350. Includes membership for the following year (2007). With option of 8 hours of volunteer help to receive \$100. track credit.

Business Membership -\$600 - can include up to 3 members in addition to owner.

Club members must be able to show their membership card and gate card to a board member, track steward, or any club member when asked to prove club membership. Un-sponsored Non-members will be asked to leave the track.

1.2 All driving non-members are subject to a \$30 practice fee. If accompanied by a member, the first non-member will pay \$15, all others subject to pay per person, per day.

1.3 **On race days, anyone other than a driver who enters the gate/property will be required to purchase and wear a wristband.** The cost will be \$10 for members and non-members. Members/participants are required to make sure their guests have purchased a wristband.

1.4 Members are responsible for having their guests sign waivers, wear all required safety gear, and follow all the club rules. **Beginning January 1st, 2006, all competitors competing in the 5-7 age group and 8-12 age group will require the use of SFI certified chest protectors. No exceptions to this rule, no chest protector, no racing.**

1.5 Race fees established include transponders, and are as follows:

Members -	1 st Kart: \$45	2 nd Kart: \$25	Kid Kart: \$35
Non-Members –	1 st Kart: \$65	2 nd Kart: \$45	

- Lost or Damaged transponders - \$225
- 1.6 Lost gate card - \$75 Replacement fee
 - 1.7 Any non-member found in possession of a gate card will have the card confiscated. The card's rightful owner will be notified and required to pay a \$75 fine for its return. Loaning out one's gate entry card and/or membership card is forbidden. Doing so will subject you to a punishment up to and including revocation of your membership.
 - 1.8 Drip pans and fire extinguishers are required in all areas of the Pits / Paddock at all times.
 - 1.9 Track hours are 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Weekend hours are 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM.

March 15th to May 15th, practice on Weekends is restricted to the hours of 3:00 PM to 7:00 PM. During this time weekday practice remains 10:00 to 7:00 PM.
NO motors may be started prior to track being officially opened for the day or after 7:00 PM.
 - 1.10 When the track is posted as **CLOSED**, there will be no use of the track. Any member using the track will lose his/her membership. Non-members will be subject to prosecution.
 - 1.11 No vehicles are to be parked on the pit area pavement. Driving vehicles in the pits to unload or load Karts and equipment is permitted. No motorized vehicles are allowed on the track except Go-Karts. ***On race days, no vehicles are allowed in the pits to load equipment until the last race is over.*** Vehicles unloading or loading equipment are to enter the pits from the north and exit to the south.
 - 1.12 No skateboards, bicycles, roller skates, scooters, motorized scooters, or roller blades are allowed at the Dixon facility during racing hours. Violators will have item confiscated and returned at the end of race day. Kinsmen Kart Club is not responsible for any damage or loss to item. Pets are to remain on a leash.
 - 1.13 No open fires.
 - 1.14 All members must have a fire extinguisher in their pits
 - 1.15 On race weekends, the back row of pit spots is reserved for use by enclosed trailers or large box trucks only.
 - 1.16 No tire doping allowed at the track. Minimum 52 durometer for YJL tires.
 - 1.17 **Any 85CC motor is subject to an adjustment of a minimum of 30 pounds or more than an 80CC motor. Starting weight for an 85CC motor could be 405 pounds or more.**
